Dear Mr. Labbe:

Pursuant to the requirements of N.J.A.C. 6A:30, the Sayreville School District has undergone the Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) review. In order to determine the scope of your district's onsite evaluation, Department staff review your self-assessment documents (Statement of Assurance and District Performance Review) and analyzed district performance against critical indicators in all five QSAC areas. As a result, the Executive County Superintendent and team conducted an evaluation in the area of instruction and program and fiscal management. Based on that evaluation and on the self-assessment results in the other three QSAC areas (governance, operations and personnel), the Department has placed the district on a continuum in all five areas. The complete QSAC results, including both the district's self-assessment and the Department's evaluation, are enclosed. The QSAC placement scores are listed below:

DPR Areas	Initial Placement
Instruction and Program	80%
Fiscal Management	98%
Governance	100%
Operations	100%
Personnel	80%

These placement results will be provided to the State Board of Education at an upcoming meeting. Please be advised that QSAC regulations require your district board of education to report these results at the next regularly scheduled board meeting.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:30-4.1(f), if your district believes that an indicator(s) was scored incorrectly, you have seven days from the receipt of this letter to submit a written reconsideration request to me. E-mail your reconsideration request to [qsac@doe.state.nj.us](mailto:qsac@doe.state.nj.us) or mail it to the address on this letterhead (Attn: QSAC Reconsideration).

I am pleased to inform you that your district has satisfied at least 80 percent of the weighted indicators in each of the five areas of the QSAC review process and has been designated as "high performing." Commissioner Hespe will recommend to the State Board of Education that your district be certified as providing a thorough and efficient system of education, for a period of three years or until the next QSAC review. Congratulations on this accomplishment.
