Good evening,

On July 17, 2017, the annual Returning Student Enrollment Update will open. As has been the practice the past several years, we will require that all parents take the time to update your child(ren)'s enrollment information. You can access this in ***PowerSchool Registration (formerly known as Infosnap)***, our online registration software. **THIS MUST BE COMPLETED BY MONDAY, August 21, 2017.** Just like last year, there will be a link entitled "***Infosnap Enrollment Update***" in each student's *PowerSchool* Parent Portal so that you can update enrollment information. Please note that this is **mandatory for all returning students who will be in 1st grade through 12th grade during the 2017-18 school year.** Unfortunately, parents who do not complete the update by the 21st will be locked out of the Parent Portal and thus will be unable to access their child(ren)'s schedule(s) when they are posted on August Wednesday 23rd.

- You **DO NOT** need to complete the 2017-2018 enrollment update if any of the following applies to you:
 - You have already registered your child(ren) as a new student for the 2017-2018 school year;
 - Your child(ren) is attending Kindergarten for the 2017-2018 school year;
 - Your child(ren) is attending any of the district Pre-School programs for the 2017-2018 school year
